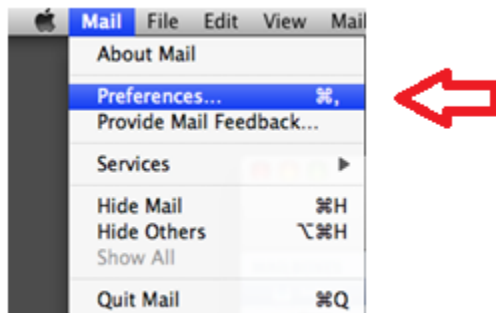


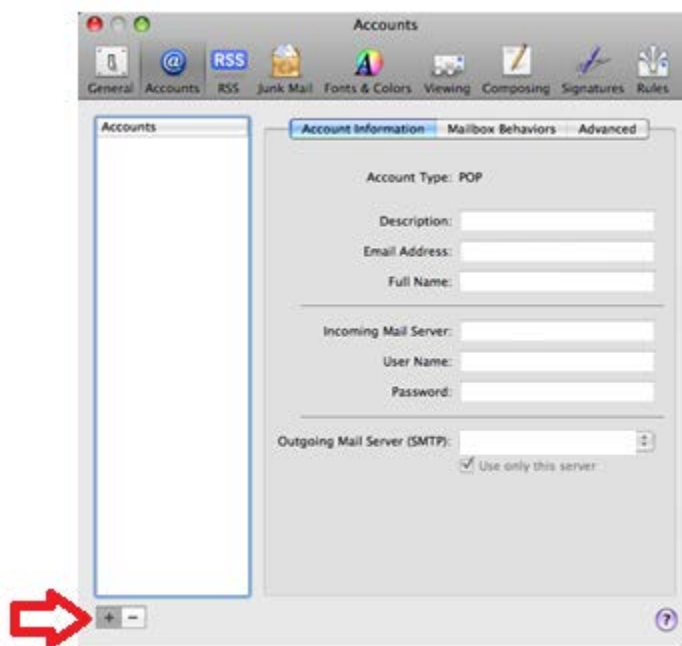
Apple Mail POP Setup

Open Apple Mail.

If you are not prompted to create an account, go to Mail -> Preferences.



Click on the + button in the lower left hand corner.



Type in your name as you want it to appear on outgoing emails. Type in your domain email address and password. Click Continue.

Add Account

You'll be guided through the necessary steps to set up an additional mail account.

To get started, fill out the following information:

Full Name: John Smith

Email Address: johnsmith@example.com

Password: *****

Cancel Go Back Continue

Type in the incoming mail server information.

Account Type: POP

Description: pop.cccinternet.net

Incoming Mail Server: pop.cccinternet.net

User Name: Your Username

Password: Your Password

Click Continue.

Incoming Mail Server

Account Type: POP

Description: pop.htenvmail.net

Incoming Mail Server: pop.htenvmail.net

User Name: johnsmith

Password: *****

Cancel Go Back Continue

Type in the outgoing mail server information.

Description: smtp.cccinternet.net

Outgoing Mail Server: smtp.cccinternet.net

Make sure "Use only this server" is checked.

Make sure "Use Authentication" is checked.

Your information should already be filled out, if not, fill it in.

Click Continue.



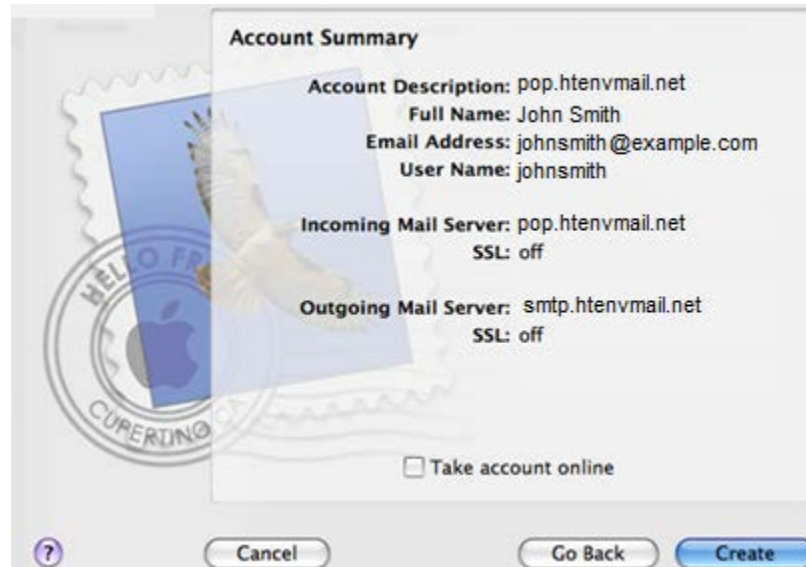
Uncheck "Use Secure Sockets Layer (SSL)".

Keep Authentication at Password.

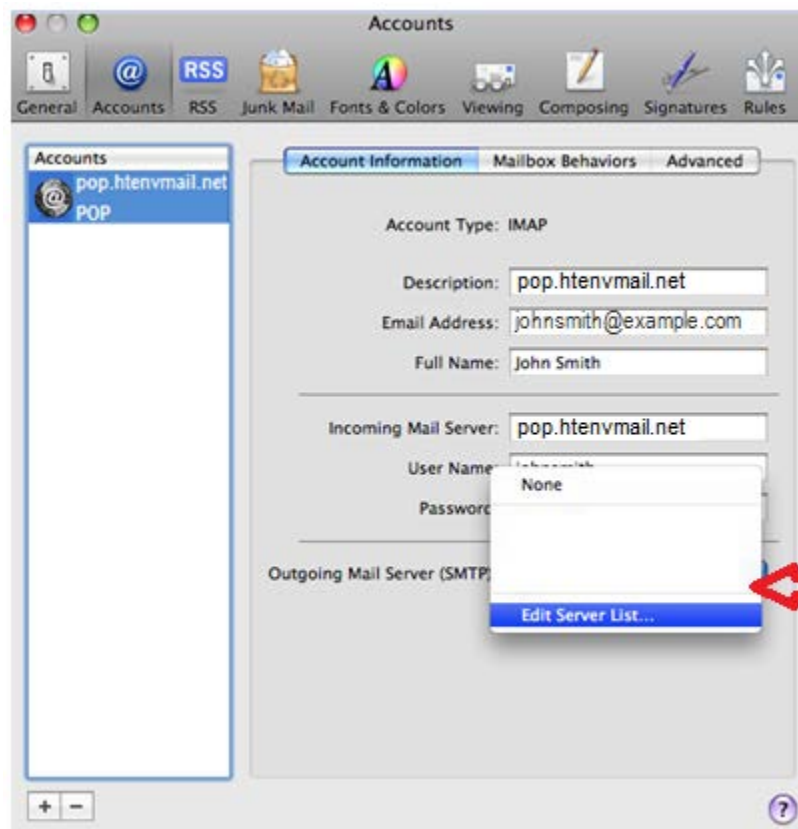
Click Continue.



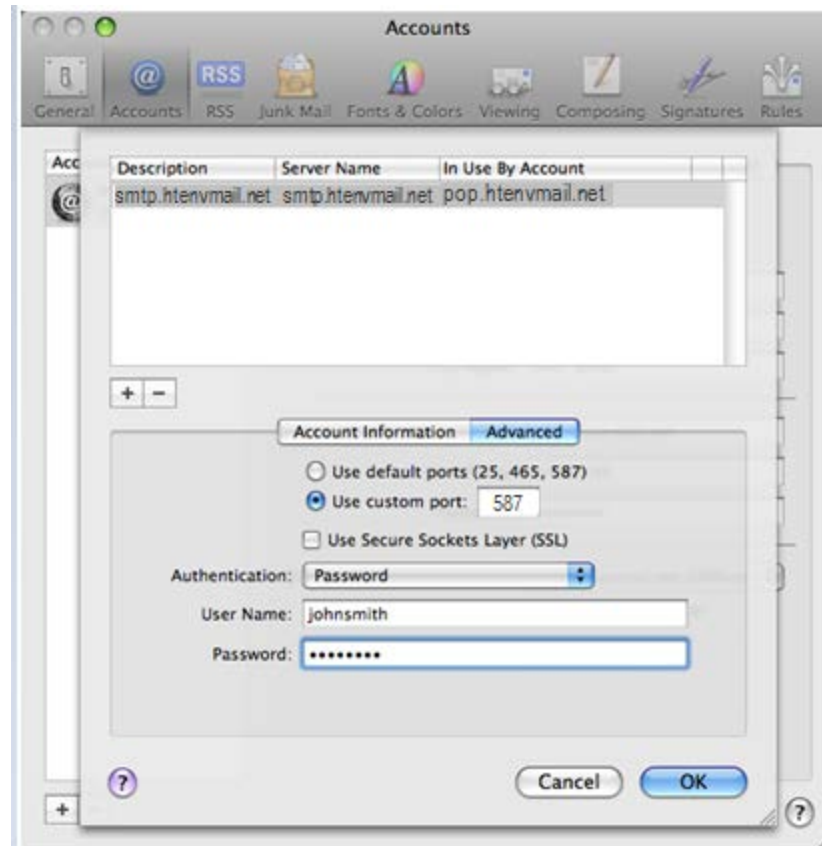
Click on Create.



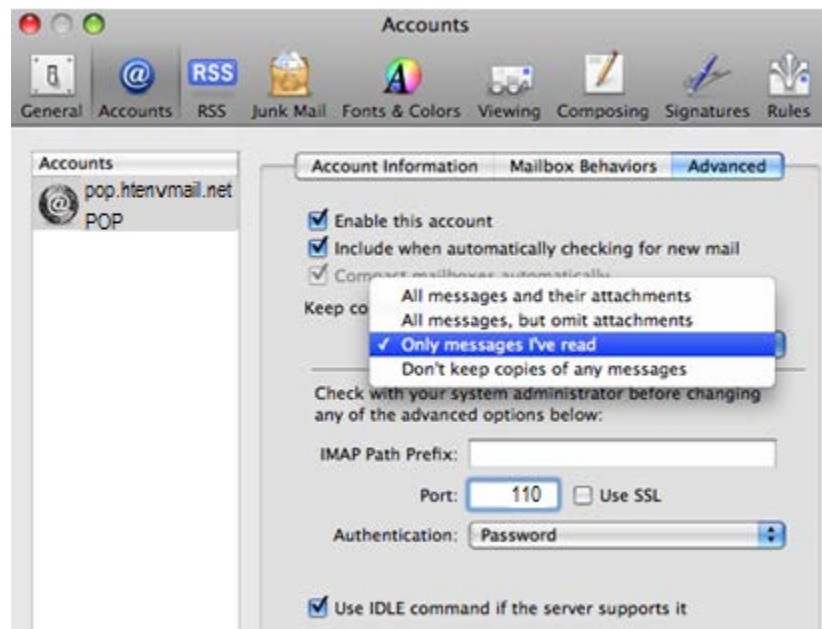
On the Accounts page, click on smtp.cccinternet.net next to "Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP)" at the bottom of this screen, and choose "Edit Server List".



Click on "Use Custom Port" and enter 587, or you can leave as default port. Either one will work. Be sure that "Use Secure Sockets Layer (SSL)" is still unchecked and that your username and password are entered in. Click OK.



Go to the Advanced tab along the top. Ensure that the Port listed is 110 and not 995, and ensure that "Use SSL" is not checked.



Click on the red button in the upper left hand corner to shut the window (being sure to click Save when it asks you) and your setup is complete!
